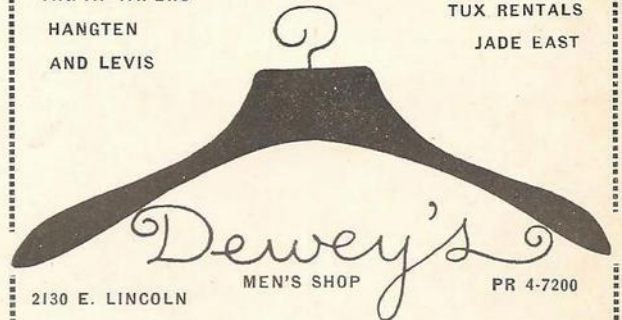

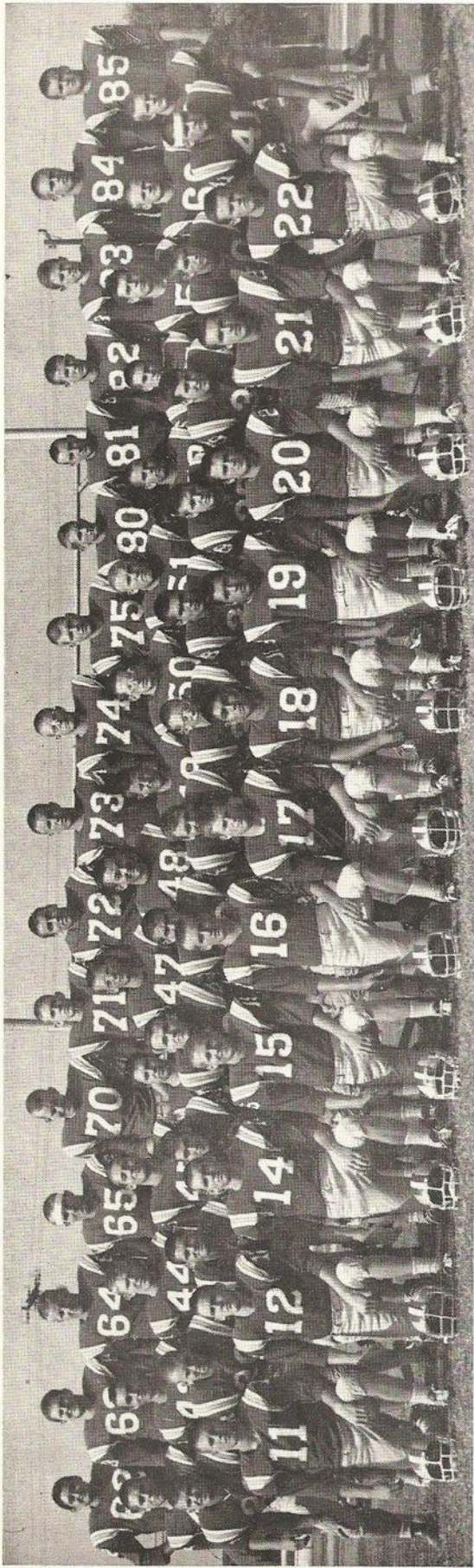

# Colonists Dominate All-League Selections

Anaheim's perennial domination of Orange County high school football was again proven as the Colony completely dominated selections on the All-Orange County and All-Sunset League rosters.

Seven Colonists were picked for the Los Angeles Times All-Orange County team. Mater Dei was second with five players. Dick Freeman, Gerry Mullins and Dave Tietge were all repeaters to the first team. Also honored were Bob Lannon, Steve Tyreman, Ron Pharris

and junior Tom Fitzpatrick. The All-Orange County players were honored last Tuesday at a dinner at the Jolly Knight Restaurant. A short film was shown of each player in action and they received patches for their letterman's jackets.

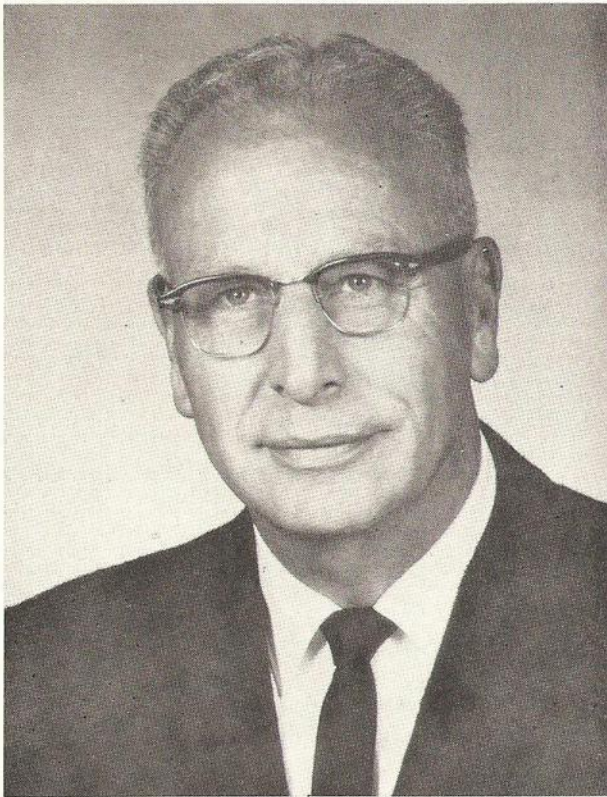
The All-Orange County Sports-writers team was chosen by a panel of 10 writers and included five Colonists on the first team plus four honorable mentions. On offense, Freeman, guard; Pharris,

halfback; and Fitzpatrick, fullback were named to the first team. End, Mullins and safety, Tietge were picked for first team defense. Receiving honorable mention were Tyreman, Wayne Bugbee guard and middleguard, and linebacker Lannon.

In All-Sunset League balloting the Colonists placed five on the first team offense, five on first team defense and one honorable mention. Named to first team of-

fense were Mullins, Tyreman, Freeman, Pharris and Fitzpatrick. Mullins also placed on defense along with Bill Doyle, Bugbee, Lannon and Tietge. Receiving berths on second team were Fitzpatrick, Jerry Palms, Jim Johnson and Walt Smith. John Ochoa received honorable mention.

Pharris and Mullins were honored as Sunset League back of the year and line of the year respectively.



CHESTER R. SHIRK  
Anaheim High School Principal

Clare Van Hoorebeke came to Anaheim High School as head coach in 1950. Since that time he has written and rewritten the football records of the "Colonists" many times.

During the 17 seasons as head coach Van has compiled the following record: 13 Sunset League Championships, won 36 of the 52 pre-season games and lost only sixteen. The Van-men have run up 84 victories, 10 losses and only four ties in regular league games. As he enters his 28th post season game in CIF competition, his record shows 15 wins, six losses and six ties.

Van was born in Riverside, Calif., but played all of his football, basketball, and baseball at Huntington Beach High School. He later defeated his Alma Mater in 9 of 11 attempts while coaching Anaheim. After high school, he went to Arizona State University, where he played football for four years. His first coaching assignment was the frosh football and baseball teams at Arizona State. From there, he went to the then newly formed North Phoenix High School.

President of the C.I.F. Southern Section council this year is Anaheim High School principal Chester R. Shirk.

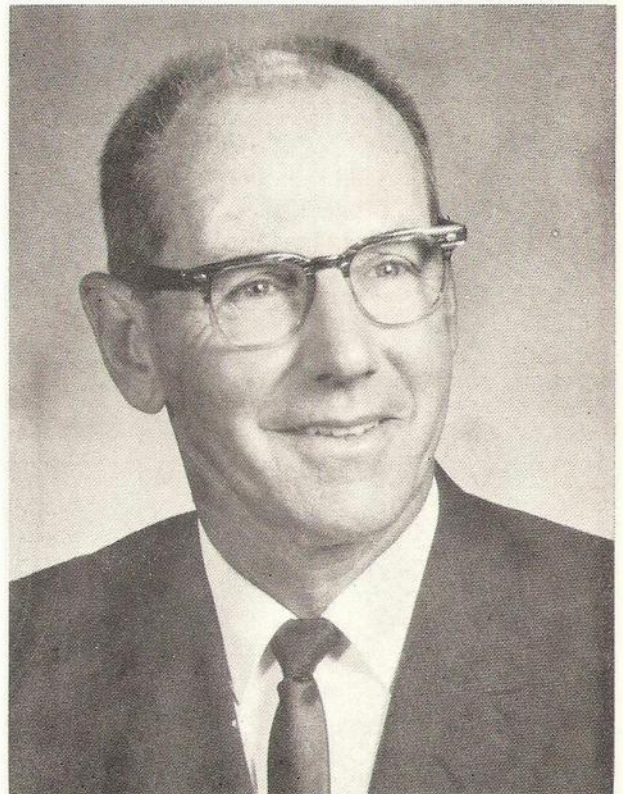
Shirk first came to Anaheim High in 1938 as a baseball and golf coach. He also coached championship B and C football, basketball and baseball teams.

In 1950 he went into the teaching and administration area. In 1954 he was named vice-principal of Western Jr. High. In 1955 he was principal of Brookhurst Jr. High and then in 1956 he was back at Western, which was opening as a high school.

Shirk is a graduate of La Verne College and did graduate work at both Stanford University and Claremont graduate school.

As representative from the Sunset League to the C.I.F., Shirk still keeps in close touch with sports. He has also been an official in the Orange County Coaches and Officials Association for several years.

Anaheim High is a three year high school with a student body of 2250. The Colonists are sole possessors of the Sunset League Championship.
